Deposit to Buy


is an account type developed to help our Representatives who do not yet qualify for a credit limit to build and maintain a good credit rating.

Getting started

- If you qualify for *Deposit to Buy* you'll be able to buy yourself a credit limit and will receive an SMS with payment instructions and Avon's banking details.
- You then need to make a once-off payment to gain a credit limit.
- Avon will keep your deposit for a 3- or 6-month trial period.

Where can I pay my deposit?

- Please use your Avon account number as your reference when paying your deposit and make sure it is the first transaction on your account.
- South Africa You can pay your deposit at a **Pay@ outlet** or **Absa.**
- Namibia You can pay your deposit at a Nampost or FNB in Namibia.
- You need to pay your deposit in full not in instalments.

What happens after I pay the deposit?

- Pay your deposit as soon as possible and you will receive a SMS informing you that you now have a **R1 000** credit limit.
- Your order will be released once your payment reflects in Avon's bank account and your order is within the credit limit.

3-month trial period

- You need to place an order and successfully pay for it before the due date for 3 months in a row.
- Avon will then transfer your deposit into your Avon account, and your credit limit will be doubled to R2 000.
- The deposit that has been transferred into your account can be used to settle your Avon account or pay off your next order.

6-month trial period

- If you place orders in any 3 months (not consecutively) in a 6-month period, Avon will transfer your deposit into your Avon account and you keep your credit limit, but it will not be doubled.
- If you do not place at least 3 orders in a 6-month period and your account is not overdue Avon will transfer your deposit back into your Avon account, but you will now be a Cash Representative.

The only time Avon will keep your Deposit is if you have an outstanding balance on your account after the 6-month trial period. The deposit will then be used to offset the balance owing on your account. If your payments for your orders are not made by due date, your account wil revert to a cash account.
